

RESOLUTION No. 9 - 2018

WHEREAS, the City of Harrisburg (“City”) wishes to actuate site acquisition, removal of collapsed obstruction and bank stabilization (“Project”) resultant of a Paxton Creek embankment wall collapse event on May 21, 2018, at 29-65 South 10th Street, Harrisburg, PA 17101.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Harrisburg (“Authority”) wishes to assist by submitting an application to the Department of Community and Economic Development of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania (PA-DCED) for Keystone Community Grant funding (“Keystone Community Grant”) in part of in full for the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Keystone Community Grant requires that Public sector applicants must provide a resolution duly adopted by the applicant’s governing board formally requesting the grant, designating an official to execute all documents, describing briefly the project scope, and identifying the requested grant amount; and

WHEREAS, Authority is a body politic and corporate organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Authority is agreeable to be the Applicant to make application to the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to deliver Keystone Community Grant funding to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the estimate of the cost of the project and its scope is \$1,100,638.09 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that Redevelopment Authority of the City of Harrisburg approves the application for Keystone Community funds in the amount of \$1,100,638.09 to the Department of Community and Economic Development of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, by this Resolution for the purpose of site acquisition, obstruction removal and banks stabilization at 29-65 South 10th Street, Harrisburg Pennsylvania 17101, as set forth herein above.
